JET TUB CLEANING

Clean your hydrotherapy tub when you are moving into a new home, or one that has been vacant for three months or more. The process below generally does a good job of cleaning the scum and oils that build up in the tub plumbing and pump. The process below includes a clean, disinfect and rinse cycle.



Drain the tub completely. There may be a ring of scum around the tub after draining, wipe this off and rinse it down the drain.	Refill the tub with COLD water, then add ¹ / ₂ cup of liquid bleach and run the jets for approximately 20 minutes.

The purpose of this cleaning is to disinfect and sanitize your tub and plumbing. As described above, you might still need to do some physical cleaning. I recommend a final rinse with cold water prior to use.
